The more you read, the better your chance of winning a prize (*Only one prize per person. You must be present to win.*)



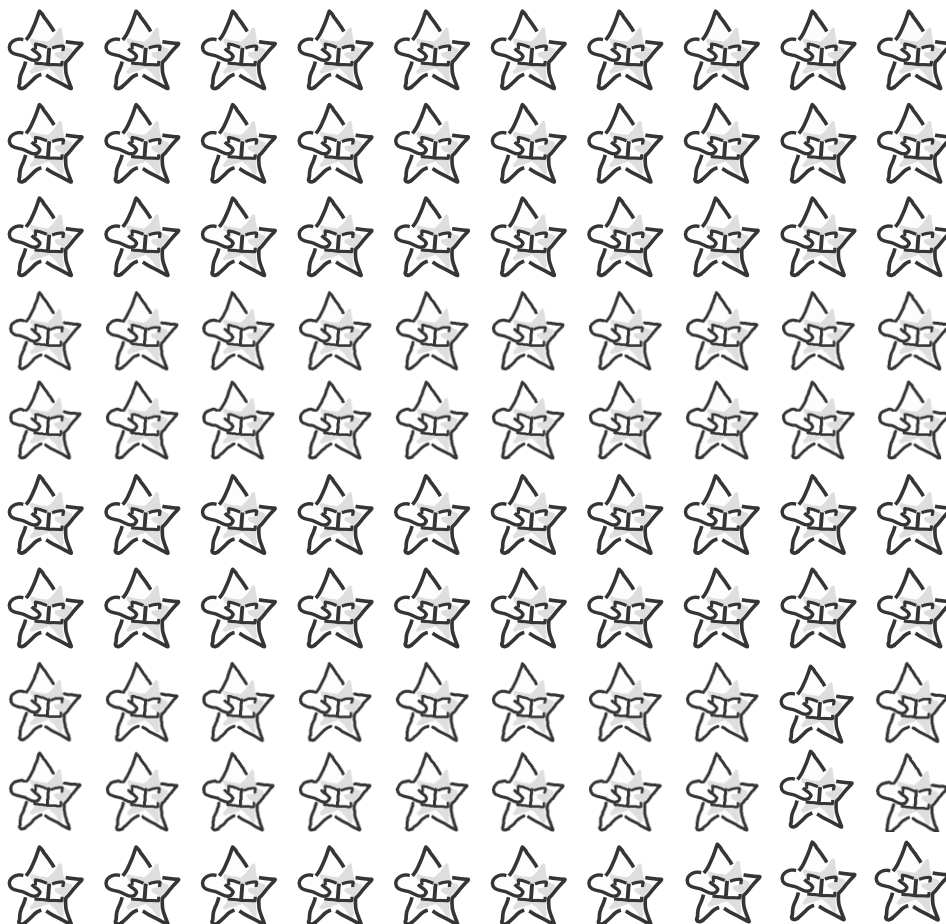
