Five United Way Donors Win Incentive Prizes

To be eligible for the drawing for the kitchen appliances, a person must have pledged to donate at least \$3 per week to the 2009 United Way of Broome County Campaign or volunteered as least 16 hours of time to an approved community project.

To be eligible for the drawing for the \$1,500 in gasoline, a person must have pledged to contribute at least \$2 per week to the 2009 United Way of Broome County Campaign or volunteered as least eight hours of time to an approved community project.

The names of the three winners of \$1,000 each in groceries were drawn from among those who have pledged to give at least \$1 per week to the 2009 United Way of Broome County Campaign or volunteered as least four hours of time to a community project.
