Vestal, New York – United Way of Broome County is scheduled to host two brief Memorial Ceremonies on Friday, September 11, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. at United Way of Broome County offices, 101 S. Jensen Road, Vestal, NY.

The morning and evening event will include a Colors Ceremony by local Veterans. Guests are welcome to attend a static display of 2,977 flags that represent and honor those who lost their lives during the September 11, 2001 attacks on the World Trade Center and Pentagon.
