Dear Friend,

Even in the most difficult situations, hope can overcome despair.

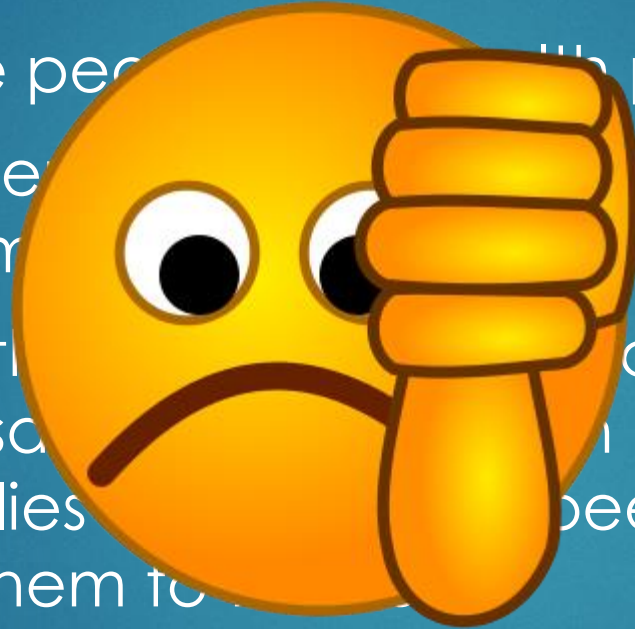
